- 508 **14 HANDS CABERNET SAUVIGNON, 2009, WASHINGTON STATE** - Subtle flavors of boysenberry, pie crust and allspice, surrounding a bright cherry core, are supported by a framework of supple tannins and culminate with a lengthy, lush finish. .... \$15.00
- 201 **ALEXANDER VALLEY, 2008, NAPA** - Shows an enticing nose of black cherry and cassis and hints of eucalyptus and cocoa. This wine delivers much more than what one might expect for a Cab so modestly priced, revealing rich flavors of cherry, chocolate and plum enveloped by soft tannins. .... \$27.00
- 767 **ALEXANDER VALLEY CABERNET FRANC, 2006** - A beautiful softness and floral nose along with notes of blueberries and mocha. .... \$32.00

- 504 **KATHERINE GOLDSCHMIDT, 2009, SONOMA** - Blackberry, black pepper, and plum flavors enveloped in sweet oak. Round and fleshy middle palate, with nice concentration and good structure. Finishes with silky tannins and a hint of spice. .... \$26.00
- 206 **KENDALL JACKSON-VINTNERS RESERVE, 2006** - Opens with deep black cherry, blackberry and cassis flavors, intense, round and well-structured provides a strong backbone throughout the middle, cedar and vanilla notes linger on the finish. .... \$31.00
- 303 **LOUIS MARTINI, 2008, NAPA** - The wine cuts a full-bodied swath across the palate and possesses silky tannins, layers of fruit and a beautiful, opulent, round mouthfeel. .... \$25.00
- 751 **MICHAEL-DAVID RAPTURE, 2004, LODI APPELLATION** - Powerful with dark plum, chocolate and tobacco flavors. Some earthy tones, finishing with soft oak. .... \$81.00
- 721 **NEDERBURG, 2008, SOUTH AFRICA** - Definite blackberry taste among its assorted flavors on the palate. Its nose is smooth and inviting and the finish is quite soft. .... \$17.00

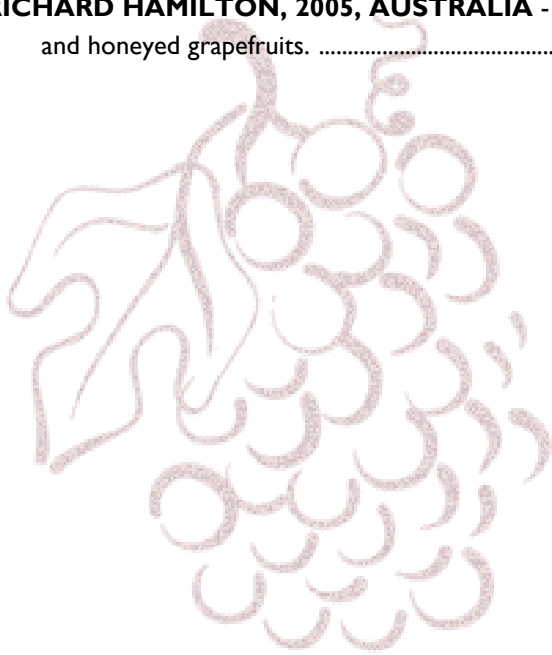

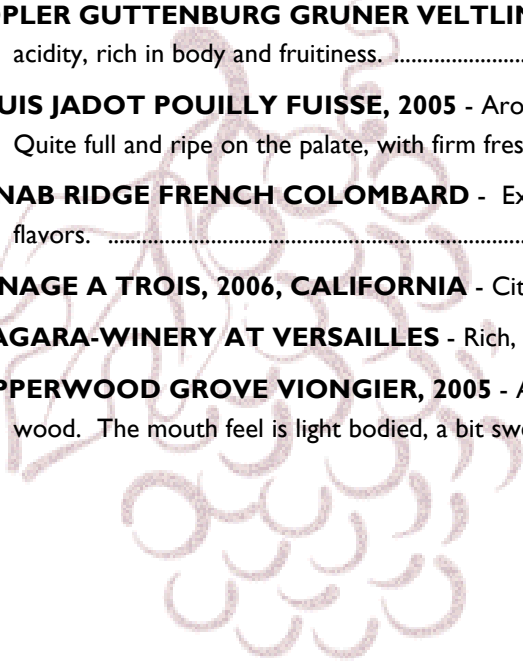
